

'Litter-Free Lent' - and being humbled

As I write, my 'Litter-Free Lent' is not turning out normally at all! On Ash Wednesday I led my first ever assembly for Jewish sixth-formers, then on Street Pastor duty I had my first encounter with human trafficking, then for the first time in my life I travelled First Class (if you book early it's cheaper than 2nd class, honest!), then yesterday my heart pounded *so badly* in a General Synod debate that I *very nearly* made my maiden speech. I have rarely felt such terror! However, I'd indicated my request to speak on the wrong electronic form. God is kind.

In each new thing I felt ignorant, naïve, clumsy, 'small' and inadequate, and I made silly mistakes. So for me, addressing the 'Litter' in my heart has started with reflection on being humbled. If you have ever felt likewise you might enjoy the following passage from the apocryphal book of **Ecclesiasticus** (or 'Sirach') ch 2:1-6. The whole of the book is well worth reading, by the way - Jesus and the apostles frequently quoted from it.

"My child, when you come to serve the Lord, prepare yourself for testing. 2 Set your heart right and be steadfast, and do not be impetuous in time of calamity.3 Cling to him and do not depart, so that your last days may be prosperous.4 Accept whatever befalls you, and in times of humiliation be patient.5 For gold is tested in the fire, and those found acceptable [are tested] in the furnace of humiliation. 6 Trust in him, and he will help you; make your ways straight, and hope in him."
