## WHIT WALKS



The first Whit Monday procession took place in Manchester city centre in 1801. That walk was from St. Anne's Church to Collegiate Church (the Cathedral).

Doreen and I decided to take part in this year's walk, arriving outside the Cathedral to see many banners from churches from Manchester and Salford. Revd. Lisa and John, with Rick, also took part in the procession which left the Cathedral at 10am. The bells rang out loudly from the Cathedral. There were bands playing and lots of children taking part, dressed as Little Bo-peep.

We made our way down Deansgate passing Kendal Milne and were joined by St. Anne's Church with their band. There was such a great atmosphere, sharing our faith with the good people of Manchester.

There must have been hundreds lining the pavements clapping and applauding as we passed by, many dressed up. I was instantly taken back to when I was a small boy wearing my new outfit holding onto a ribbon walking with my Church of St. Andrew in Ramsbottom.
